RULES OF PLAY:

1. Scramble format, better known as “Best Ball”. Every player hits from the tee, wherever the best shot lies, that is the shot you take. It is **NOT** necessary to play a drive from each player. The other three players will pick up their balls and drop them where the best ball lies, but not closer to the green. All players hit and you continue as stated above. There must always be four shots taken, if you are playing with less than four people, someone in your foursome must hit for the missing players (you **MUST** alternate these extra shots between your team members).
2. **Please pick up ball once you are at double bogey to keep pace** & mark score with asterisk to indicate pick-up.
3. ONE mulligan allowed per player (\$5 each). CANNOT use on Par 3 holes. Remember - golf is a game of honor!
4. Score - Keep one score for the entire team.
5. Men will be playing from the white tees. Women will be playing from the red tees.

PRIZES: NO Mulligans on Tee Shots – Hole Monitor **MUST BE** Present

- 1st Place, 2nd Place and 3rd Place
- Ladies Closest to the Pin # 17
- Men’s Closest to the Pin # 17
- Ladies Longest Drive # 4
- Men’s Longest Drive # 4
- High Gross
- **Hole in One:** #9 - Harley, #15 – Car & Stereo/Computer (Choice), #17 - Golf Clubs
- **Circle of Excellence:** #10 – Optional \$10 minimum bet per person before your tee shot, which if it lands in the 10 ft. circle around the hole, you share 50% of the pot with others landing in the circle and 50% benefits the Foundation. Each \$10 you bet is a share of the pot if you land in the circle (e.g. \$20 gets you 2 shares of the pot).
